

### Lancer Magazine Cinch Instructions

The Lancer Magazine Cinch was designed to be used with the L5 30 round magazine, the width of the cinch components matches the ribs on the magazine, proper installation is required for reliable operation.

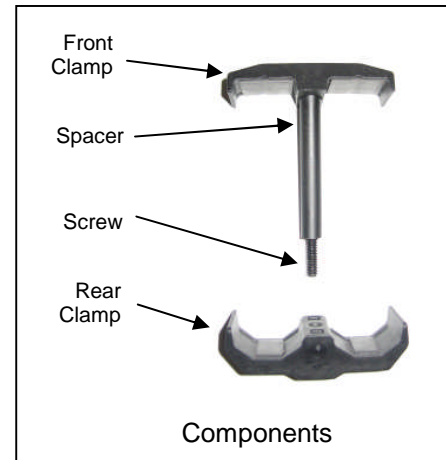
#### Installation – L5 Translucent Magazine

1. Align the magazines as shown in figure #1
2. Place the Rear Clamp on the magazines as shown in Figure #2
3. Insert the Screw through the front of the Front Clamp and then slide the Spacer over the Screw from the other side of the Front Clamp. NOTE: Failure to install the spacer could result in over tightening the Cinch, compressing the magazine and causing a stoppage.
4. Place the Rear Clamp on the magazines as shown in Figure #3
5. Install Front Clamp, Screw and Spacer as outlined in step #3.

**CAUTION: When cinching together two L5 magazines it is recommended they be downloaded to 28 rounds. When two full magazines are cinched together take care not to slam or slap the magazine when inserting it into the rifle, the L5's are flexible around the feed lips, if the magazines are slapped or slammed into the magazine well a round can be dislodged from the other magazine.**

#### Installation – USGI / Aluminum / Steel magazines

Install as outlined above, do not use the spacer; it's not necessary with the metal magazines.

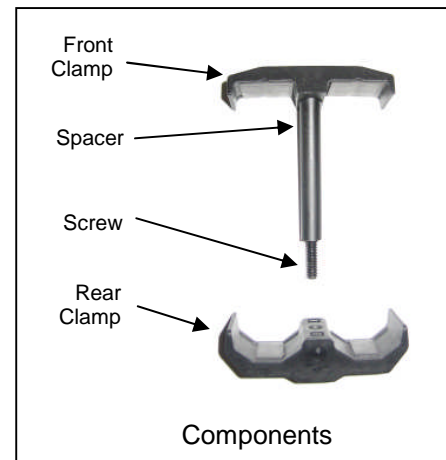

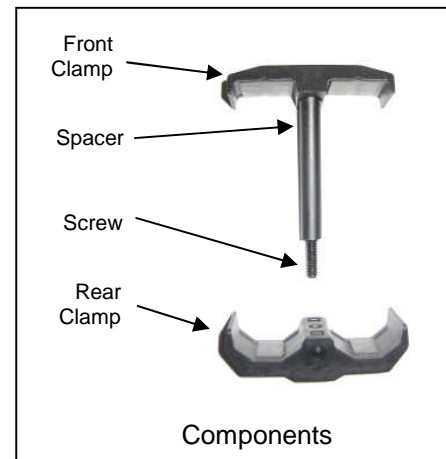

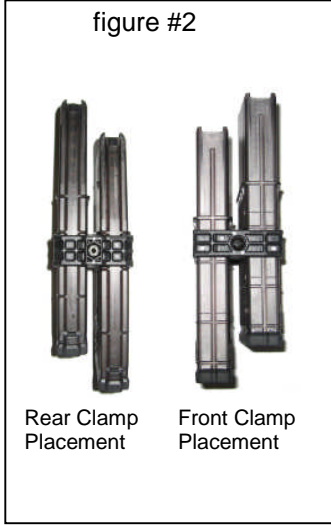
